

## COMPUTER-BASED TESTING (CBT)

### FE (Fundamentals of Engineering) and FS (Fundamentals of Surveying)

- Testing Sites: Pearson VUE testing centers located throughout US (see <http://cbt.ncees.org/where-will-i-take-my-exam/> for locations)
- Testing Dates: The computer-based FE and FS exams will be administered during four testing windows throughout the year. January-February, April-May, July-August and October-November. Registration will be open year-round.
- First available exam date: January 2, 2014, registration opens November 4, 2013.
- Registration Process: NO PRIOR APPROVAL needed from the Board. Registration is directly with NCEES.

Currently enrolled students or graduates of EAC/ABET, ETAC/ABET, or ASAC/ABET programs will register directly with NCEES also. NO PRIOR APPROVAL needed from the Board.

- Fees: Paid directly to NCEES using a VISA or MasterCard credit or debit card.
- Exam Results: Given as “Pass” or “Fail”. NCEES will post 7-10 days after examinee takes exam
