
If you wish to obtain status as an “**Engineering Intern**” in North Carolina, you will need to complete the certification application on our website (<http://www.ncbels.org/forms/EngStudentApp.pdf>), include official copies of your transcripts (in a sealed envelope with registrar’s signature/seal across back flap), three professional references (one of which must be a PE), and submit a \$100 certification fee with the application. All transcripts must show degree and date awarded.

Those who have Technology Degrees, Engineering Intern certificates/status will be delayed until you have obtained four (4) years of progressive engineering experience.

Engineering Intern Certification is not required in order to take the PE exam or to become licensed as a PE in North Carolina.
