

CBT - Surveying Fundamentals Examination (FS Exam) Passes

Dear Examinee:

The North Carolina Board of Examiners for Engineers and Surveyors congratulates you on achieving a passing score on the FS exam. This achievement represents completion of the initial step toward licensure as a Professional Land Surveyor.

Examinees that have completed a BS degree in Surveying and wish to obtain status as a **“Surveyor Intern”** in North Carolina will need to submit the Survey Intern Application (<http://www.ncbels.org/forms/SurveyInternApp.pdf>), to include other required paperwork, and a map drawn to G.S. 47-30 Mapping Requirements as described on the Application Checklist (<http://www.ncbels.org/forms/LScklist.pdf>).

Examinees with an AAS degree in Survey Technology with four (4) years experience or a High School diploma with 10 years experience will have to provide evidence of completed education/experience requirements before receiving their Surveyor Intern certification.

Surveyor Intern Certification is not required in order to take the PS exam or to become licensed as a PLS in North Carolina.
