

**Principles and Practice of Land Surveying Examination Failures
(PS Exam and NC State specific)**

This is to inform you that you did not obtain a satisfactory grade on the recent written examination administered by the North Carolina State Board of Examiners for Engineers and Surveyors. In order to be licensed in accordance with Chapter 89C of the North Carolina General Statute you are required to pass this examination.

The Board of Examiners encourages you to make every effort to successfully complete the examination and licensure process. Any questions that you may have about your performance on this exam must be pursued within thirty (30) days of your receipt of this notification.

To re-apply for PS exam you will need to register with NCEES for a re-exam. NC Board of Examiners no longer administers the PS exam. EXAM FEE IS PAID DIRECTLY TO NCEES UPON REGISTRATION.

To re-apply for the NC State specific Surveying exam, please complete the “NC Re-Exam Form” located in the “Forms” section of our website. This exam is administered by the Board at the NC Board of Examiner’s office during the months of **January, April, July and October**. (See website for actual dates as they change each year).

EXAM FEE IS SUBMITTED DIRECTLY TO NCBELS WITH RE-EXAM FORM.

A candidate with a combination of three (3) failures or unexcused absences shall only be eligible for re-exam after 12 months from the last examination and additional requirements for multi-fails is enclosed.

Remember, NCEES registration deadline dates are different than NCBELS. See their website for current registration dates.
