The North Carolina Board of Examiners for Engineers and Surveyors offers congratulations upon passing the National Principles and Practice of Surveying Examination with NCEES.


To proceed with licensure you are required to pass the NC State-Specific Surveying examination also. This examination is administered by the North Carolina Board of Examiners for Engineers and Surveyors.

To apply for seating for this exam you will need to complete the Professional Land Surveyor's application to include all applicable paperwork on NCBELS website under "Applications and Forms". The "Application Checklist" is your guide to items that must be submitted for approval.

Upon passing the State-specific exam you will have met the legal requirements for professional licensure and will be entitled to practice your profession and use the title **Professional Land Surveyor** in the State of North Carolina.

Your official paperwork, pocket card and *Certificate of Licensure* will be forwarded to you by mail upon passing.
